There is a catch-22 at the heart of open banking that is retarding its uptake, a survey of participants has found: banks are reluctant to invest in new features that tap data under the regime because of a perceived lack of consumer demand, and the absence of valuable and interesting alternative products means customers have few reasons to shift away from unregulated data sharing, which is rife across the economy.
